

The railroad museum is in the process of moving many items in our Emily St. Yard. This is due to pending construction on neighboring properties.

On Wednesday, 4-14-2015, Damon Meeks, owner and operator of Superior Crane and Transport Co. arrived with his truck crane at 8:00 am, and began assisting volunteer museum members in moving rail and other heavy items in the Emily St. Yard. Damon has helped the museum many times in past years moving narrow gauge box cars, rail, track ties and track hardware. 
WHAT'S COMING UP?

SLO TRAIN DAY will take place on Saturday, May 9th. It is a celebration of the completion of the first cross-country railroad, and cities all over the U.S. will be having festivities and events. OVERLAND TRAIL PRIVATE CAR EXCURSION: On Saturday, June 20th, a few more people will have the opportunity to ride in luxury on the beautiful Overland Trail fully restored lounge car. We are offering two options. The morning trip leaves SLO on the early Surfliner at 6:55 am. After an hour's stop in Santa Barbara, you will return on the Overland Trail, getting in to SLO about 1:00 pm. On the afternoon trip you leave SLO on the Overland Trail at 1:55 pm. Again, there is an hour stop in Santa Barbara, then return to SLO about 8:30 pm on the evening Surfliner. Cost is \$100 per person for either round trip.
