



Our new program, called Train Tales, is finally off to a start. In the next two weeks, we will be interviewing Bob McEntire and Vince Cipolla, both former Southern Pacific employees. These men are extremely knowledgeable about the S.P. in the Central Coast area and we are very excited to have the opportunity to get some of their remembrances and stories recorded for the future. This is an ongoing program and we invite any present or former employees of any Central Coast railroad to contact us and be interviewed about your work. Don't be shy! We want to hear from you.

Finally, we are pleased to announce that we have not one, but two, major fundraisers in the works. The first is an elegant dinner which will be held at Trilogy in Monarch Dunes on April 23, 2015.
